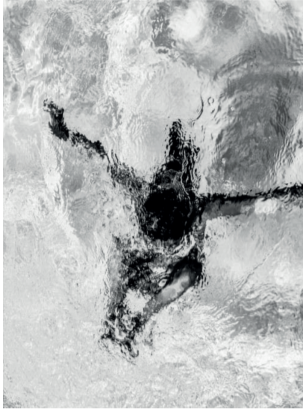

HYPERCONNECTIONS



The main concept is to coalesce, to dilute in nature, understanding that we are part of it, the nature of the archipelago gives us the opportunity to escape from the monotony of city life and reconnect with our deepest roots. Hyperconnections are about flowing without a reason. The experience is a magical encounter with another reality, where unusual sensations awaken in us. Nature envelops us with its splendour and invites us to experience a sense of freedom and wonder, leaving us in awe of the beauty that surrounds us. The islands are a natural refuge, where we find calm, peace and where the spirit can be reborn.

The geometric patterns are simple and straightforward gestures based on relations of concave and convex duality, seeking objects of high architectural quality, which are light, dynamic, serially manufactured, but with infinite variations, ensuring that anyone can enjoy the natural space.

EASTERN ARCHIPELAGO

A local boat route is proposed to connect the new recreational areas to nearby communities. This new connection will allow easier and quicker access to recreational areas, some of which have so far been little explored, enriching the experience of residents and tourists alike. They will now be able to enjoy hidden spots, nature trails and other amenities such as saunas and cafés, thus promoting interaction and cultural exchange. Additionally, this initiative promises to contribute to the sustainable tourism and economic development of the region, while respecting and preserving the natural beauty of the archipelago. For the marine connection to the city centre new stops are added, public transport should reach all the islands that are intervened, thus ensuring that more people have access, the land connection of public transport has stops close to the ports near the islands.

VARTIOSAARI

It is structured in a simple way with two routes that connect the whole island and consolidate and condition the existing connections, the northeast connection is solved with a solar ferry, which provides a sustainable and accessible solution for visitors or people who simply want to cross the island, cultural and educational tourism uses are promoted. The villas owned by the city will be rehabilitated and transformed into social facilities to promote and celebrate art and culture.

The villa in the northern area in Jatasalmi has been converted into a leisure centre that complements the sports facilities, improving sports courts and offering a range of options for active entertainment. In Reposalmi, the intervention has transformed the pier into a meeting point for relaxation. With dry toilets, wooden shelter and spaces with chairs and tables complementing the pop-up café. The sauna and swimming area has been upgraded for greater comfort, while the villa's gardens have been rehabilitated and opened to the public, turning the villa into a dream destination for tourists. In addition, the island reinforces the agricultural structures and enhances the artists' spaces, creating an atmosphere of inspiration and creativity.

VILLINKI

To the west of the island there will be a public transport connection, the swimming area to the east will be reached walking, the main network of paths that connects the different areas will be better, just know define the second hierarchy networks that will make accessible the entire area in a regulated way directing flows, and allows easy and comfortable way to access services and areas of special interest and small corners to relax. Public areas for recreation are spread throughout the island, inviting you to explore and enjoy every corner of its natural beauty.

PIKKU NIINISAARI

It is fitted out with basic services, and the existing buildings are improved, with a gently sloping perimeter circuit, which connects the whole area and is also accessible to the villas. Thanks to this, visitors will be able to experience the magic of this place without compromising its ecological integrity. The endangered areas are protected and inaccessible, while the peripheral path remains open for future connections, generating new networked routes.

The island is intended to become a sustainable and environmentally responsible destination, while promoting gradual and careful development. This remote island is emerging as a natural treasure, where the marriage of basic services and environmental preservation intertwine to provide an unforgettable experience. Responsible tourism can be a positive force in the protection and recovery of our natural treasures.

MALKASAARI

This island offers a unique accommodation experience that is complemented by the new use of the villa primarily for guests, with laundry or kitchen facilities, the ten modules have been grouped to the northeast, providing comfort and privacy. The island has a perimeter path, with a gentle slope, allowing for an easy and relaxing walk. Along this route, toilets and landing sites are conveniently located to meet the needs of visitors. In addition, the vegetation zone is preserved, especially in the centre, where endangered species live. In order to protect, it has been decided to delimit the area, enclosing the stone wall, restoring it, and it is finished off with additional fencing to ensure the complete protection of the vegetation and keep it in its purest and wildest state.

Visitors will be able to enjoy an unforgettable stay, surrounded by breathtaking scenery and simple comforts, all in perfect harmony with the natural environment that the island strives to protect and conserve. Simple actions are being taken to make the new facilities energy self-sufficient, the favourable orientated roofs of the new and old buildings will have solar panels, rainwater will be collected by means of sloping roofs.

KOTILUOTO

The garden is rehabilitated respecting its old structure, the garden becomes a multicultural space where multiple outdoor activities can be held for small groups, activities such as recitals, parties, art exhibitions, market, garden shows, etc. It could be rented for special celebrations, the cultural character will be complemented by the village. This cultural revival will add a new dimension to the natural beauty of the island and leave an indelible impression on those who experience it. As part of the plan, connections have been made to existing paths, creating a network of trails that invite visitors to explore. Amidst this captivating environment, essential amenities will be grouped together for visitors to enjoy, including a café and kitchen shelter, and existing dry toilets will be upgraded.

All the interventions are based on the same criteria:

- Recover and restore old structures, buildings and gardens.
- To enhance the current uses with simple interventions that condition the place for enjoyment.
- The basis for all the interventions is to adapt to the pre-existence.
- New buildings for services such as cafes will only be necessary if there is no nearby city-owned villa available.
- All buildings have to be easy to assemble and dismantle.

All recreation areas need supporting elements such as forest and biological cycle control, maintenance, self-sufficiency and ecosystem regulation. Depending on the complexity of the site, the pieces can be brought in ready-assembled in a factory as a panel, or built on site in a simple, handcrafted way.
